## INCOHERENCY AND INCONSTANCY OF LEGISLATION ON PARTIES AND ELECTIONS IN POST-COMMUNIST ROMANIA

Abstract. The paper aims to explore the norms that have regulated, over two and a half decades, the founding of political parties and the mechanisms by which we elect our representatives and militate for the necessity of harmonizing and unifying the procedures after which all the elections are organized into an electoral code.
